Fake stamp papers worth 10 million seized

Criminal Investigation Department (CID) sleuths of West Bengal Police recovered several fake nonjudicial stamp papers worth Rs 10 million from the house of Tapan Das at Kharida in Kharagpur in West Midnapore district July 15, 2012. However the accused had fled before the arrival of the police.

The fraud came to light when the state vigilance commission instructed the district registrar to conduct a probe into the matter based on the complaint lodged with the additional director general of police by an RTI activist. During the course of the investigation, it was revealed that the racketeers have a nationwide network and the racket could be worth several billons of rupees. The fraud has been committed mostly by stamp vendors and a few state government employees who are involved in the nationwide racket. West Bengal Government is losing revenue to the extent of Rs 2,000-Rs 3,000 billion.

Prasad by Post

India Post has entered into an agreement with the Kashi Vishwanath temple of Varanasi and Mahakaleshwar temple of Ujjain to deliver the sacred 'prasad' from these two temples to the devotees via post.

For the prasad from Kashi Vishwanath temple the devotees are required to send money order of Rs 60 in the favor of Postal Superintendent, Varanasi (East) and in return the will get a packet containing 'bhabhuti' (holy ashes), Rudraksh, a laminated photo of Lord Shiva and Shiv Chalisa.

For the prasad from Mahakaleshwar temple the devotees are required to send money order of Rs 151 in the name of Manager Shri Mahakaleshwar Temple Management Committee, Ujjain. The temple authorities, in return, would send the prasad comprising of 200 grams of dry fruits, 200 grams of ladoo, 'bhabhuti' and the photo of Mahakaleshwar.
