RAKHI ENVELOPES

This year India Post reissued same 4 designs as last year in the Dupont Tyvek material all over India. However 4 postal circles had advertisements on 2 or 3 selected designs. Last year only Rajasthan Postal Circle had advertisements on Rakhi envelopes.

This year Rajastan innovated further and had a new design different than the 4 released all India for its sponsor. Rajastan also brought out a Rakhi package priced at Rs 25 consisting of everything, except sweets, i.e. a Rakhi, a Rakhi greeting card, a Rakhi envelope affixed with a Rs 5 stamp, and a sachet of color a& grains of rice for Tilak.

In all we have 11 different envelopes reported this year.

AUCTION ACTION

Christoph Gärtner of Germany http://www.auktionen-gaertner.de will be holding autumn auction on 4 days from September 11 to 14, 2007. There are several lots of India interest in this auction of nearly 15000 lots and we have detailed the one India lot estimated at over half a million Euros in the previous issue.

On September 14, 2007 the Gartner will auction the first part of the archives of Fournier, the Security Printer from Spain. This archive contains hundreds of unique items like drawings of adopted and unadopted designs, die-proofs, plate-proofs, color-proofs, progressive-proofs, etc from 40 countries printed in the 60s till the early 90s. This is an excellent opportunity for thematic collectors.

Professor Dr Damian Läge, the president of the FIP Thematic Commission, has written a comprehensive article with the help of the Fournier Archives. We believe that this article is going to be the standard reference to correctly identify the whole range of archive material. INDIA POST'S FIRST FLIGHT A Raja, Minister of Communications and Information Technology launched the India Post Freighter for North East at Guwahati on August 29, 2007.

India Post has taken a landmark decision to have its own air freight operations in North East. A Boeing 737-200 has been chartered from Indian Airlines, for one year to begin with, to operate on Kolkata-Guwahati-Imphal-Agartala-Kolkata sector.

Indian Airlines after its recent merger with Air India is now known as Air India. This event also launched the newly formed Air India Cargo Service.

India Post has brought out a First Flight Cover on this occasion that is available at all philatelic bureaus.

RECENT & FORTHCOMING EVENTS

Aug 24-26: Cochin, Coins & Stamps Exhibition The Kerala Numismatic Society, Kochi have conducted 3 day Coin and stamp Exhibition and a dealers bourse at Town Hall, Kochi from August 24 to 26, 2007 in conjunction with the most important festival of Kerala, Onam. Around 40 dealers from all over India have participated in this event.

Though the size of the exhibits is small, the collectors of coins and stamps had an opportunity to see some of the fine collections of silver, gold coins of Cochin and Travancore state. Also three Scinde Dawks were on display by a philatelist from Trichur.

Two special covers were released, one each on the August 24 and 25, 2007. The release of a cover on board "Stella Maria" overshadowed all the other events. In the evening at 8 PM the Post Master General Shoba Kosy released the cover in the Arabian Sea and was received by Paul Alukkas the chairman of Alukkas group of Companies, Kochi. The organizers claims the issue of a special cover on board of a ship is the first time in world history such an event have took place. A limited 500 covers were issued at Rs.100 each. Some covers were autographed by the mate of the ship and the PMG. The boat returned back after 4 hours with an onboard auction for stamps and coins for 1 hour.

William Re 1 coin went up to Rs 850 and sold and a set of UPU & Mask miniature sheet realized Rs 1400 is the highlight of the auction. The hospitality extended to the dealers and guests by the Society is worthy of mention.
