NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

MARKAND DAVE IN CUSTOMS NET

The leading national and some regional newspapers broke the news on April 14, 2010 about an incidence involving Markand Dave of Nadiad, a leading philatelist and stamp dealer. On Saturday April 10, 2010 when Dave was on his way to Frankfurt, he was stopped by officials from the Customs department at Ahmedabad International Airport, based on a tip-off.

He was found carrying philatelic material over 100 years old. The Indian Antiquities and Art Treasures Act 1972 provides that items over 100 year old cannot be taken out of the country without permission from the Archeological Survey of India.

Dave was produced before the Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate R C Joshi, who sent him to judicial custody. Dave has filed a bail plea, which will come up for hearing on April 16, 2010.

At the time of sending this issue the result of the bail plea hearing is awaited, we shall update you with more information as and when it is available.

Meanwhile two questions are looking for their answers:

- 1. The identity of person who tipped Customs and the beneficiaries thereof. The majority in Indian philatelic community believe that he was trapped by his business rivals.
- 2. Why judicial custody for Dave as in all similar cases in past where individuals were caught with carrying antiquities no one was taken in to custody.

NEW STAMPS RELEASED

India Post released a set of 12 postage stamps in the denomination of Rs 5 each on Astrological Signs on April 14, 2010. A miniature sheet accompanied the issue.

Bharti Mirchandani designed the Stamp, Miniature Sheet, and the First Day Cover. Alka Sharma designed the pictorial first day postmark and the Brochure containing write-up and technical data. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 2 each. India Security Press, Nasik printed 0.8 million stamps each by wet offset process. The miniature sheet was produced in the quantity of 0.8 million.

While making the withdrawal please make sure to select the purpose code that best fits seller's business.

Any proceeds or earnings received into sellers PayPal account from the export of goods and services may only be withdrawn to seller's bank account in India.

This received amount cannot be reused for making purchases. For purchases on any website that accepts PayPal, one can continue to use any credit card issued by a bank in India.
