STAMPS OF INDIA NATIONAL EXHIBITION

FOR THE EXHIBITORS Stamps of India National Exhibition introduces a few innovations not only in exhibiting but also in judging the competitive stamp exhibitions in India. The exhibitors now have a choice to exhibit 1, 3, or 5 frames in each class. However for 8 frames the regulation remain as before that is previously obtaining a minimum of 85% marks at a national level show. This move is to facilitate and empower the exhibitors.

The 5 and 8 frames exhibits have traditionally been evaluated together. Hitherto the 1 frame class was being judged by same regulations in same classification although separately than 5 and 8 frames. Several Asian International Shows have been providing for a 2 or 3 frames. In India exhibitions de facto have also been providing 3 and 4 frames. Stamps of India National Exhibition took this opportunity to rationalize and expand the choice for the exhibitor. The introduction of 3 frames class will serve as the midway stop from 1 to 5 frames.

Stamps of India National Exhibition also introduces two new classes - Picture Postcards Class and Freedom Class. The Picture Postcards Class is further subdivided in to India and Rest of the World. Picture Postcards are a popular sideline and many a philatelists do dabble in it. This class will provide an opportunity to these philatelists as well as hardcore Picture Postcards collectors to showcase their collection to a larger audience.

The participant in Freedom Class has total freedom to display philatelic items in any which way. The only restriction being that exhibit must fit in to a standard philatelic display frame of 1 x 1.25 meter. The emphasis in this class is on innovative presentation that will appeal to a wider range of audience and not only to the philatelists. The exhibitor has to impress the visiting public who also will be playing a significant role in the evaluation of the exhibit under this class.

The duly filled forms should be mailed to SINE GHQ, BG-5/49-D, Paschim Vihar, New Delhi 110063. The last date to submit the application form is July 31, 2010.

The good news is that SINE GHQ decided to offer an early bird rate of Rs 12,500 for bookings made before June 30, 2010 after which the regular rate of Rs 15,000 will be applicable. The bookings of Sales Stall has already commenced on June 27, 2010 from 8am as was announced in the previous issue.
