India Post released a stamp in the denomination of Rs 5 on Corps of Signals of the Indian Army on its centenary on February 4, 2011.

Sankha Samanta designed the Stamp and the First Day Cover. Alka Sharma designed the pictorial first day postmark. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 2 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed 0.3 million stamps by Wet Offset process.

V Subbiah

India Post released a stamp in the denomination of Rs 5 on the birth centenary of V Subbiah, freedom fighter and political leader on February 7, 2011.

Nenu Gupta designed the Stamp, the First Day Cover, and the pictorial first day postmark. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 2 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed 0.3 million stamps by Wet Offset process.

Census of India

Pratibha Patil, the President of India, released a stamp in the denomination of Rs 5 on the Census of India on February 8, 2011.

Royal Mail Commemorates INDIPEX 2011

Royal Mail will issue on February 12, 2011 a vibrant, colourful sheet to celebrate the INDIPEX International Stamp Exhibition in New Delhi, it features a reproduction of the Mahatma Gandhi Centenary stamp issued on 13th August 1969 - the first stamp in the UK to commemorate an overseas leader.

The sheet comprises 20 First Class 'Union Flag' self adhesive stamps with labels featuring scenes from around New Delhi including the Lotus Temple, Jama Masjid Mosque, India Gate, the Akshardham Temple and the exhibition venue, Pragati Maidan Exhibition Centre.

The sheet consists of two identical halves each having images of old and new Delhi, and the British 1969 Gandhi Centenary stamp, on labels alongside the self-adhesive Union Flag stamp. The sheet will be on sale from the Royal Mail Philatelic Bureau and philatelic outlets.
