June 2011 will be a new issue free month in India. India Post will not issue any new stamps in the month of June this year. Last time this happened was in 2007 when June and July were new issue free months. In the first 12 years of new millennium this is happening only for the fourth time. Earlier and June and July of 2000, January, July and August of 2003, and July of 2004 were new issue free months. In other words out of 144 months India post issued new stamps in 135 months that is 0.6%

We all are stamp lovers but the absence of new issues provides a welcome relief and breathing space especially in the time of the flood of new issues by India Post in recent years
