New Stamps Released

India Post released a set of 2 stamps on India Israel Joint Issue to mark the 20th anniversary of the diplomatic relations on November 5, 2012. The stamps are in the denomination of Rs 5 each and depict Deepavali and Hanukkah, the Festivals of Lights of Indian and Israel respectively.

The stamps were released in individual sheets of 40 and in Se-Tenant Sheetlet of 20. The arrangement in sheetlet gives 2 different horizontal and 2 different vertical se-tenant pairs.

Alka Shrama designed the Deepavali stamp, the First Day Cover, Brochure and the pictorial First Day of Issue postmark. Ronen Goldberg designed the Hanukkah stamp. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 2 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed by wet offset process a total of 800,000 stamps - 200,000 stamps in sheets of 40 and 600,000 stamps in Sheetlets of 20.
