From 14 to 17 June 2013 Uttarakhand received heavy rainfall, which was about 375 percent more than the benchmark rainfall during a normal monsoon. This caused heavy floods in Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and Western Nepal, and acute rainfall in other nearby regions of Delhi, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and some parts of Tibet. In the city of Dehradun, capital of Uttarakhand, this was the wettest June day for over five decades. Heavy rainfall for four consecutive days as well as melting snow aggravated the floods and landslides causing thousands of people to be caught unaware, resulting in huge loss of life and property. The damage to bridges and roads left over 100,000 pilgrims and tourists trapped in various places. The Indian Air Force, the Army and paramilitary troops have displayed heroic and selfless courage and commitment, saving the lives of thousands.

New Philatelic Publications

Stanley Gibbons India Catalog 4th Edition

The Stanley Gibbons India & States color catalogue was published on June 15, 2013. It lists and prices the mint and used stamps of India from the earliest issues of Sind Province (1852) and the East India Company (1854-64) to early 2013. The catalogue includes details of Indian stamps used abroad, with fully priced listings in several cases, also the stamps of Indian Expeditionary and Custodian forces overseas and the issues of the Indian Convention and Feudatory States. Major plate flaws, watermark varieties, shades, official stamps and booklets are all listed. Telegraph stamps have now been added. A lot of prices have been revised. The 356 pages catalogue is priced at GBP 27.95 about Rs 2,650.

Year Book of Indian Philately: 2012

The 2012 edition of the Year Book of Indian Philately is now out. It includes important philatelic texts on some important subjects in Indian Philately, like

- Ashok Bayanwala has authored an article on Indian "P Stamps", known as "My Stamp" in India, a very contemporary subject about very interesting & colorful philatelic collectibles, encompassing the history of "My Stamp" from the very first issue in 2001 to the date.

- An exclusively commissioned article on "Indian Service Stamps", a sinfully ignored aspect of Indian Philately until now. The article highlights some unlisted & unknown-till-now denominations of Post-Independence Indian Service Stamps. Service stamps were discontinued in 2001; but the article reveals that these are still being printed & distributed by the department with un-deniable proofs and pictures of the specimen.

- Naresh Agarwal has penned an illustrative text on "Indian Bazaar Cards", a very interesting and reflective component of the Indian Postal Stationery of Pre-independence era. The article throws all-round light on these cards, which are an integral part of the Indian Postal History and of the Social History as well.

- Dr Satyendra Kumar Agarwal, has added the flavor of the Thematic Philately to the Year Book's this edition with his well-researched illustrated article on "Miniature Paintings of India".

- Ilyas Ahemad Patel has added his article on "Indian Bridges in Philately".

- "Virtual Philately", is the subject of the write-up by Sudhir Jain.

- The Preface of the 2012 edition of the Year Book has a write up highlighting the "Importance of the Local Philatelic Organizations", the foundation stones of the organized philately, in totality and modern contexts.

- Some more useful texts, assembled by the Editorial Team of the Year Book for this edition include, India's New Meter Marks: RMFM Marks; e-Philately: list of useful philatelic web-sites; Philatelic Code of Ethics, & Global Philately: Significant World Philatelic Organizations.

- the Year Book 2012 also records details of the happenings of 2012 in Indian Philately which include, Indian Awardees at International Shows, Issue Program for 2013, Indian Issues of 2012 (including miscellaneous issues), Postal History 2012, Events & Society News 2012 & Philatelic Tidbits from all over the world. - Details of the current Indian Postal rates including for the Premium Services of India Post like Speed Post (including International Speed Post), Greetings Post, Media Post, Bill Mail Service, Direct Post & so on.

- A three part bibliography for the editions of the Year Book is also integrated in the edition for the readers' ready reference. Three parts of the bibliography are focused on The Individual Articles, The Subject wise Classification & the Authors.

Launch of Logistics Post Air Service

India Post has started "Logistics Post Air Service in Association with Air India on identified sectors amongst 15 linking airports, Agartala, Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Nagpur, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Chennai, Pune, Ahmedabad, Imphal, Guwahati, Patna, Lucknow & Trivandrum (Thiruvananthapuram). The main features of this service include:

(i) First Category: Airport. Customer to deposit the consignment at the postal facility available at the airport premises at Logistics Post Air Booking Centre, Palam TMO, New Delhi – 110037 and the delivery will be effected to the customer at the post office facility at the destination airport.

(ii) Second Category: City to City (on payment of additional charges). On payment of City to City charges, the consignment will be booked at Logistics Post Air Booking Centre, RMS Bhawan, Delhi - 110006 and the delivery will be effected at the Logistics Post Delivery Centers in the Destination city. (Minimum additional charges Rs 50 per consignment @ Re 1 per kg).

(iii) Third Category: Door to Door (on payment of additional charges). Pick up from the premises or delivery at the premises of the consignment (Minimum additional charges Rs 100 per consignment @ Rs 2 per kg).

Charges shall be as per volumetric weight rates to be followed in accordance with IATA standards (6000 cubic cm = 1 kg for the purpose). There will be four types of rates for Logistics Post Air Service viz.

(i) Standard rate - For consignment upto 49 kgs.

(ii) Bulk Rate (BA) - For 50 kgs to 99 kgs.

- (iii) Bulk Rate (BB) For 100 kgs to 249 kgs.
- (iv) Bulk Rate (BC) For 250 kgs & above
