India Post issued a notification stating that general public will get new stamps issued on 100 years of Indian cinema in June on a date to be announced. June has since come and gone and it is now two months since the date of issue, May 3, 2103. There is no date of sale announced.

Sources say that it will not be before August 15, 2013 that stamps are made available. The emphasis is on 'not before' and it is not to say that stamps will be available on August 15 or around that date.

Record Indian Participation in BRASILIANA 2013

46 exhibits were accepted for participation competitively in **BRASILIANA 2013 world stamp exhibition**. This is a new record high for Indian participation in a world exhibition held outside India. This breaks the previous record of 45 exhibits in ESPANA 2006 where the national commissioner from India was Madhukar Jhingan. In ESPANA 2006 India had the highest number of exhibits after the host country, Spain.

Monika Khanna Gulati designed the stamp, and the First Day Cover. Alka Sharmadesigned the pictorial First Day of Issue postmark. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 5 each. India Security Press, Nashik printed by wet offset process a total of 410,000 stamps.

Royal Philatelic Society Meeting in New Delhi

The meeting was a great success as 11 new members have applied for membership and many of them was supported as second proposer by RPSL current New Delhi based member Ashish Talwar who runs Aries Auctions.

Meeting was started with new member's enrollment and introduction. Thereafter Markand Dave honored Anil Suri by offering him the RPSL badge. He is the man who won 18 Gold Medals in FIP exhibitions in Indian States & Revenue area, He said He was RPSL member in 1980s was convinced to re-instate his membership. Anil Suri presented a beautiful canvas painting of Lord Krishna with his flute to Markand Dave on his appointment as RPSL Representative in India.

Vishal Butan came with his wife Diena and interestingly they both are philatelists. Vishal is a chemical engineer and collects British India and Diena is a painter and a keen observer of colors and she helps Vishal in identifying certain distinct shades when it comes to carmine or scarlet , both had

appreciated and purchased RPSL badges and enjoyed the meeting a lot. They had very actively taken part during the discussion.

Madhukar Jhingan also applied for membership, the well-known face of Indian Philately who runs the website www.stampsofindia.com with over one million hits per month from where he also publishes the weekly newsletter.

Harsh Gupta the great collector with a very wide collecting interests and a dynamic young personality gave a tribute to Jeffrey Brown, Doyen of Indian AeroPhilately, on his sudden death.

The idea of displaying each other's item again worked well. Shiv Shankar Somani brought an excellent example of Queen Victoria - East India used from Malcca, cancelled with B-109, an unrecorded example in Stanley Gibbons Catalogue which was an exceptional item enjoyed by the members very well. Harsh Gupta's 1929 Airmail cover - Redirected more than 7 times was again a great pleasure for members. Anil Suri's Gold Medal winning collection of Indian states - Cochin was also on display. Markand Dave's presentation sheets of Danish Sett in India was very much appreciated by our newly applied for member Vishal Butan. Markand Dave gave a presentation in New York's Collectors Club in 2011 on this. Markand Dave also displayed his articles on 1854 India Lithograph stamps.

Markand Dave then read out messages from M A Sayeed FRPSL – Dubai, P K Khaitan – Mumbai, Sahil Sood – Delhi, and Damyanti M Pittie – FRPSL.

An idea of exchange of telegram message by RPSL members in India was proposed by Markand Dave and members have happily accepted it. Newly applied for member from New Delhi Parvesh Gupta had kindly expressed his willingness to deal with Telegraph office on behalf of all New Delhi members. One short message will be sent by Markand Dave to all members and all members in India have been requested to send one short message to Markand Dave, A composition of all last day messages will be lovingly donated to RPSL by its Indian Members.

Meeting was followed by dinner. A special thanks to member Jatin Patel of Ahmedabad and a freelance photographer for covering the meeting.
