## PCI Elections Results 2015

The Governing Council of the Philatelic Congress of India (PCI) was reconstituted on December 13, 2015 at Mumbai following the elections, as under:

The elections were conducted by Election Officer Professor Sahadeva Sahoo assisted by Jagmaohan Kapur. Sahoo appointed Pradip Mohanty and Lal Makhijani for Institutional voting and S C Sukhani and C J Vincent for Life members' voting.

The elections results were as under:

For the 17 seats of the Institutional Members, 12 were declared unopposed, no nominations were received for 2 seats, and remaining 3 seats were contested as follows:

Rajesh Paharia scored 92% of the vote polled.

Total voters 84, Total votes 504, Polled 405

Kaizad Todywalla scored 67% of the votes.

The newly formed Governing Council in its first meeting following the elections inducted Binod Jain to represent the North East (Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura, and Sikkim) from where no nomination was received. Another seat for which no nomination was received for the elections is West Bengal and it will be filled in the next meeting of the Governing Council. In addition up to 3 persons may get nominated to the Council later.

### Ved Parkash Dhawan Passes Away

Ved Parkash Dhawan passed away on December 4, 2015 at Patiala. He was 79. He was a well known stamp dealer hailing from the internationally well known firm of B L Dhaun and Sons that was established in 1906. It was succeeded by Sohan Lal Dhawan & Sons in the next generation. Ved Parkash Dhawan was the third generation stamp dealer and his elder son Sanjay Dhawan of the fourth generation is carrying on the family business.

He successfully exhibited and won Gold medals at State level, served as a member of the Jury and was honoured by the Philatelic Congress of Punjab with an award of honour.
