New Stamps Released

INCOME TAX APPELLATE TRIBUNAL

Pranab Mukherjee, President of India released a commemorative postage stamp in the denomination of Rs 5, the inland letter rate, on Income Tax Appellate Tribunal as part of its Platinum Jubilee Celebrations on January 24, 2016 at New Delhi. D V Sadananda Gowda, Minister for Law & Justice, Justice T S Thakur, Chief Justice of India, and Kavery Banerjee, Secretary (Posts) & Chairman Postal Services Board were present on the occasion.

Alka Sharma designed the stamp, the First Day Cover, and the First Day of Issue postmark. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 5 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed by wet offset process a total of 400,000 stamps each in the sheets of 45 stamps each.

VIBRANT INDIA

India Post released a commemorative postage stamp on Vibrant India on January 25, 2016 at New Delhi. The stamp in the denomination of Rs 25, the overseas airmail letter rate, is issued in miniature sheet format only.

Nenu Gupta designed the Miniature Sheet, the First Day Cover, and the First Day of Issue postmark. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 5 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed by wet offset process a total of 300,000 miniature sheets.
