## Guide to Expenses for Participation in BRASILIANA 2013 World Stamps Exhibition

The Exhibitors are required to bear the following expenses incurred for his/her exhibit in proportion to the frames allotted in all classes.

## Participation Fee -

For Classes 1–9 US\$ 50 per frame For Class 10 (Youth): No entry fee

For Class 11 (Philatelic Literature): US\$ 50 per exhibit

For Class 12 (One Frame): US\$ 70

The current rate of exchange is approximately Rs 55 to a US \$.

In addition there will be a small charge to be incurred on account of transferring the funds to Rio de Janeiro.

The fees are payable to the National Commissioner for India by July 5, 2013.

Insurance Charges – For all classes except Class 11 (Philatelic Literature)
The insurance charges for insuring the exhibit from exhibitor's place to Rio de
Janeiro and back via New Delhi

For Class 11 (Philatelic Literature):

There is no charge on account of insurance.

For Exhibits having Antiquities (over 99 year old items)

The Archaeological Survey of India evaluates the antiquities and advises the amount to be insured.

For Exhibits not having Antiquities

The exhibitor communicates to National Commissioner for India the amount to be insured.

The insurance charges are estimated to be Rs 500 for Rs 100,000.

The Insurance charges are payable to the National Commissioner for India by July 5, 2013.

Freight – For all classes except Class 11 (Philatelic Literature)

In accordance of the article 51.1 of the General Regulations for Exhibitions of International Philatelic Federation (FIP GREX), revised on June 24, 2012, the exhibitors will bear the charges for sending and returning the exhibits.

The cost of freight from New Delhi to Rio de Janeiro is estimated at Rs 1,500 per frame.

While returning the exhibit the additional freight for catalog of Exhibit, awards list, medals, special prize if any, and the certificate

The expense of returning exhibits from New Delhi to exhibitor's place in India

For Class 11 (Philatelic Literature)

All literature entries to BRASILIANA 2013 will be forwarded to Rio de Janeiro on September 7, 2013 by Air Registered Parcel. The cost of delivery is estimated at Rs 1,000 to 2,000 per exhibit.

These are payable to the National Commissioner for India by October 31, 2013.

## Special Prize from India

Exhibitor contributes towards the cost of a Special Prize given at BRASILIANA 2013 from India. The cost of a prize usually is Rs 5,000 and is equally divided in to all exhibits.

This amount is payable to the National Commissioner for India by July 5, 2013.

**Other Expenses** *if any*, incurred in obtaining the various permissions from the various departments of the Government of India

Custom Duty *if any*, levied by Indian Customs on the awards and or special prizes won by the exhibitor

Incidental expenses <u>if any</u>, incurred for a particular exhibit on an account not covered above

Expenses incurred on account of postage, courier, telephone, fax, stationery, photocopying, transportation within Delhi and the bank charges.

An account for the amount received from the participant along with the expenses incurred would be submitted to each participant at the time of the return of the exhibits. Any short payment would need to be paid prior to the return of the exhibit. Any excess receipt will be refunded to the exhibitor at the same time.
