BEWARE OF RUMOR MONGERS

Lots of philatelists in the country recently heard that Baburao Puleshwar Shedmake commemorative stamp issued on March 12, 2009 is being withdrawn by India Post. The ready reason offered for this action

was that the portrait depicted on the stamp is incorrect and is not of Shedmake!

Well, all this was not true and the rumor was spread by vested interests who aimed at selling the Shedmake stamp to 'investors' for several times of its face value. These are same group of persons who were responsible for flaring up the prices of Madhubala and Sai Baba stamps about this time in 2008 to unsustainable levels, 20 times of its face value in 30 days, from which they naturally had to crash.

FORTHCOMING STAMP ISSUES

We understand that Election Commission of India has asked India Post to refrain from issuing new postage stamps in view of Code of Conduct that came in to force with the announcement of General Elections 2009. Thus the next issues are expected only after the results are announced on May 16, 2009.

As you can see that the world is moving at very fast pace and we are still bringing out an issue only after 7 long days.
