New Stamps Released

INDIA SINGAPORE JOINT LSSUE

Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India, and Lee Hsien Loong, Prime Minister of Singapore, jointly released the India Singapore joint issue stamps, in Istana, Singapore on November 24, 2015. The joint issue commemorates the 50th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between India and Singapore.

India Post issued set of two commemorative postage stamps in the denomination of Rs 5 and Rs 25 depicting Istana and Rashtrapati Bhavan, the official residences of the President of the Singapore and India respectively.

Alka Sharma designed the Indian stamp, the First Day Cover, and the First Day of Issue postmark. Wong Wui Kong designed the Singaporean stamp. The First Day Cover and the Brochure are priced at Rs 5 each. Security Printing Press, Hyderabad printed by wet offset process a total of 300,000 stamps in the sheets of 45 stamps.

In addition of issuing the set of 2 stamps, and the First Day Cover, Singapore Post issued a Presentation Pack and Commemorative Sheet. The Commemorative Sheet contains one stamp each of Singapore and India in the denomination of 1st Local (\$\$ 0.30) and \$\$\$\$\$2 respectively. This is for the first time that an Indian stamp is part of a Siamese twin joint issue product. The stamps in the Commemorative Sheet is printed by Secura Singapore Pte Ltd, Singapore by offset lithography process in the sheets of 10 stamps each. This is for the second time since independence of India that an Indian stamp is printed abroad. The first time was when Mahatma Gandhi memorial stamps of 1948 were printed in Switzerland.

The stamps of Singapore are available online at http://www.singpost.com/philately-a-stamp/stamp-shop.html. There is no charge for international delivery.

Ashok Kumar Dash, Chief Post Master General of Maharashtra Circle, released a commemorative postage stamp in the denomination of Rs 5 to mark the diamond jubilee of the Engineering Export Promotion Council of India (EEPC India) on November 24, 2015 at the 5th edition of India Engineering Sourcing Show (IESS), Bombay Exhibition Centre, Mumbai.

Jiri Koliba, Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic, Ravi Capoor, Joint Secretary Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Tarvinder Singh Bhasin, Chairman of EEPC India, Ravi Sehegal, Senior Vice Chairman of EEPC India, exhibitors, overseas buyers and 10000 trade buyers were present at the function.

ePost Office App

India Post has recently has introduced Mobile Application for purchase of Stamps and other Philatelic items from its 'ePost Office'. The App is currently available only for android devices. For download please visit Google Play Store on your smart phone. The App is developed by India Post's Centre for Excellence in Postal Technology (CEPT), Mysore.

This is the second App from India Post, the first was Postinfo released earlier this year. The Postinfo, is also an android Mobile application developed by CEPT and provides Tracking, Post office search, Postage Calculator, Insurance premium calculator, and Interest calculator.
